Monique Van Dormael has been working since 1976 in the field of health service organisation. From 1976 to 1986, she accumulated field experience in health centres and group practices in Belgium, collaborating with first line care practitioners on quality improvement. She conducted an action-research, which led to the introduction of capitation payment in health centres in Belgium. In 1986-87, she conducted at the ULB a study on the functioning and co-ordination of services in the field of mental health care for elderly.

In 1987, she joined the public health department of the Institute of Tropical Medicine in Antwerp. In 1995, she obtained a PhD in social sciences with a thesis on the construction of professional identities in first line care. She has teaching responsibilities in the Master Courses (socio-anthropological aspects of health, communication skills, qualitative research methods in public health, health service organisation and management). She has experience of research and field project guidance in Mali, Niger, Thailand, Bolivia, Ecuador and Morocco. Her research activities relate to health system strengthening, with special focus on social and organisational determinants of quality of health care, motivational determinants of providers' behavioural patterns and interactions between Global Health Initiatives and local health systems.
